- **Exam Duration:** 120 minutes
- **Late Arrival:** Candidates arriving after the first 15 minutes of the exam will not be allowed into the exam room.
- **Exit Restrictions:** No one is allowed to leave the exam room during the first 15 minutes and the last 10 minutes of the exam.
- **Exam Language:** English
- **Exam Content:** The exam consists of 50 multiple-choice questions, each worth 2 points. Incorrect answers do not reduce the points of correct answers.
The exam will be conducted in person.
- The questions will be prepared based on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) at the B1+ level. The exam will cover the following areas: Grammar 14 questions, Functional Language Use 12 questions, Vocabulary 12 questions, Reading 12 questions.

Details of the Exam Sections:

Grammar: This section assesses candidates' understanding of grammar rules and their ability to use these rules correctly. The questions in this section focus on testing grammar rules.

Vocabulary: This section measures candidates' vocabulary range and their ability to use words correctly in meaning and context. Questions in this section are based on the meaning relationships and uses of words.

Functional Language Use: This section evaluates candidates' ability to understand how language is functionally used in real-life situations. It tests the candidates' ability to select appropriate language expressions for specific situations and communicate accordingly.

Reading: This section tests candidates' ability to read texts reflecting real-life situations, and their skill in understanding the essence, details, and structure of a text.

- **Exam Result:** The exam will be scored out of 100 points. Students who score 55 points or higher will be considered successful, and they will receive a certificate of exam results.
- **Required Documents:** Candidates must bring their student ID, Turkish ID card, or passport with them to the exam.
- **Validity of the Exam:** The validity of the exam results is 2 years.
